

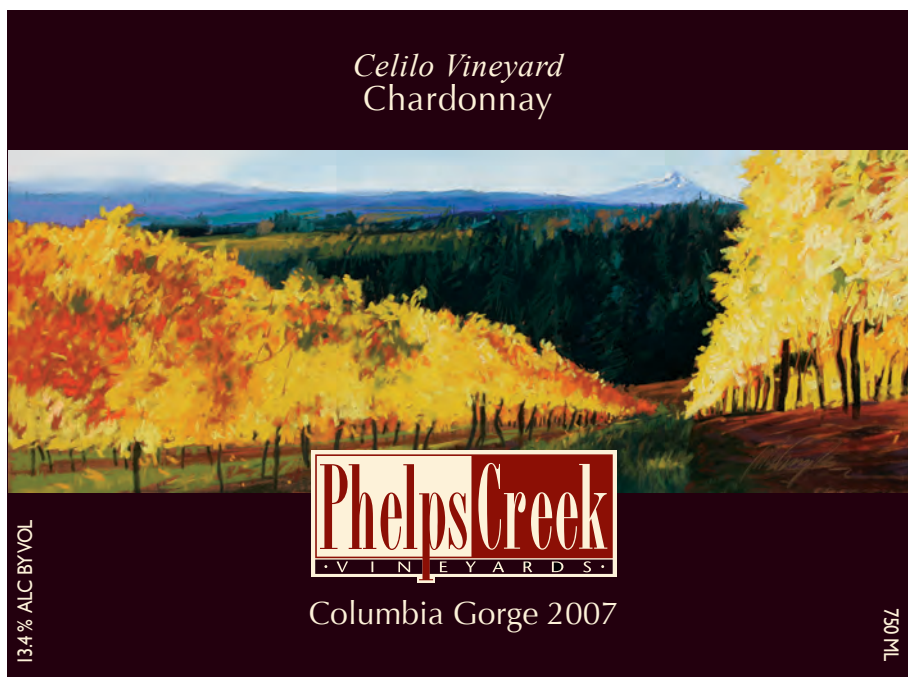
2007 *Celilo Vineyard* Chardonnay

An intense bouquet of spicy oak, nutmeg, cinnamon and vanilla lead to pineapple, lemon and green apple fruit aromas in this rich and dense wine. The flavors are layered with oak/spice/toast over pineapple/lemon flavors. The finish is succulent yet dry and long. This will cellar beautifully.
