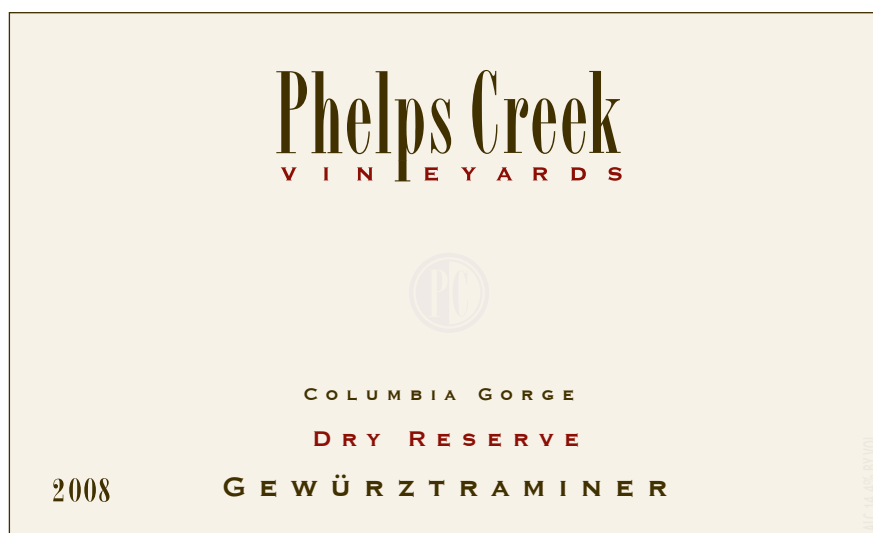


# 2008 Dry Reserve Gewürztraminer Phelps Creek Columbia Gorge VINEYARDS

Classic Gewürztraminer perfumed aromas of carnations, spice and lavender are backed with hints of citrus/tropical fruits. The flavors are very dry and full-bodied with floral/melon/spice character. The balance and length are excellent and finish shows toast and flint.
