

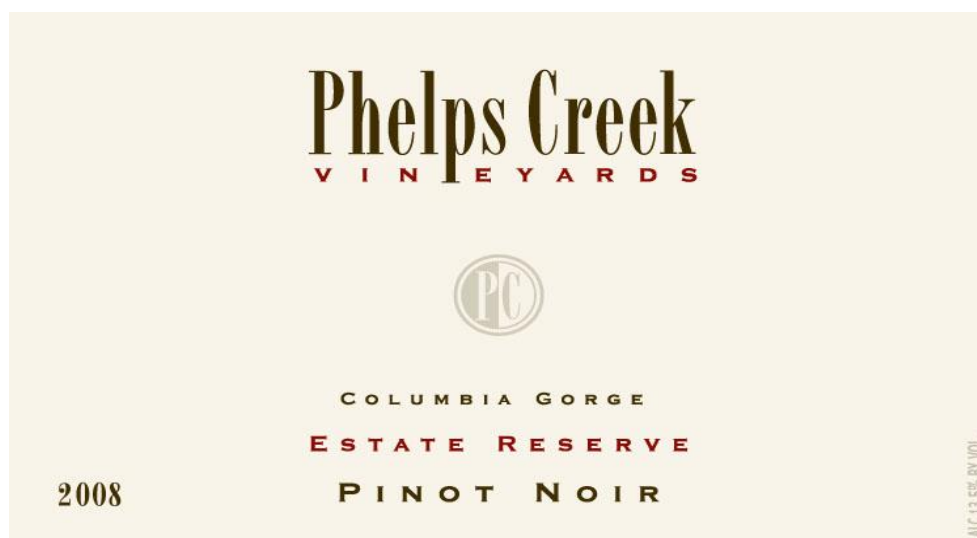

"The 2008 Pinot Noir Estate Reserve was aged in 71% new oak. Darker in color than the two preceding wines, it provides a captivating nose of sandalwood, smoke, mineral, violets, black cherry, and black raspberry. Plush, ripe, and velvety-textured, it is jam-packed with savory, spicy fruit and has enough structure to evolve for 3-4 years. The lengthy finish is round and seamless.
