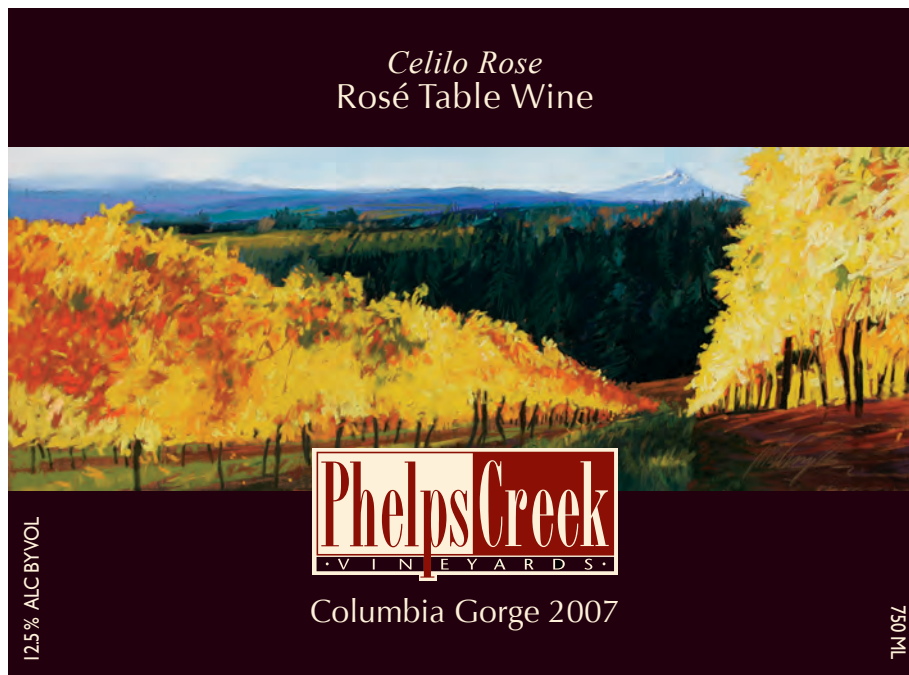


# 2007 *Celilo Rose* Rosé of Merlot Columbia Gorge



The nose shows loads of pretty fruit – crushed berries, cherries and a touch of lavender perfume. Medium bodied with a clean and focused entry with red cherry/cassis/raspberry flavors backed by her/spice/flint notes with a dry and long finish. Delicious with grilled seafood, summer salads and perfect for picnics.

<b>Fermentation</b>	Cold soaked for 4 days then pressed Fermented in neutral oak barrels On lees, stirred as needed for 6 months
<b>Bottling</b>	May 13, 2008
<b>Alcohol</b>	12.5%
<b>Total Acidity</b>	6.7 g/l
<b>pH at bottling</b>	3.38
<b>Residual sugar</b>	0.4%
<b>Production</b>	342 cases
